More Computers For P.V. Police Academy

Gil and Marti Correa de Garcia returned to Puerto Vallarta on March 26th and set about to purchase two additional computers, adding to the nine purchased a month ago. The computers were funded by Santa Barbara Rotary North Foundation and the SB/PV Sister City Committee.

The computer classroom is now fully equipped with a total of 11 computers, 9 of which were previously purchased thanks to the generous donations of Santa Barbara Sister City Committee, Rotary Club of Santa Barbara North, Roberto and Esperanza Najera and Puerto Vallarta sister city Committee.

The Dolphin Fountain, created by Bud Bottoms and the foundation created by architect Gil Garcia was moved from its original location to the entrance of the Malecon several years ago, but it lacked the plaque created in 1987. That plaque gave credit to the creators and Santa Barbara Sister City, the organization which donated it.

That has now been corrected as shown at left, with Gil Garcia standing by the new plaque which was recently installed and which SB/PV also funded.


Donated Exercise Equipment for Rehabilitation Clinic

SB/PV Sister City appreciates Los Angeles resident Paul Taylor's donation of gym equipment that will be sent to Santa Barbara Rehab Clinic in Puerto Vallarta. The equipment will be used for patient rehabilitation treatment.

The clinic was constructed in early 1990 by Santa Barbara Sister City and Rotary Clubs In Santa Barbara & Puerto Vallarta. A community board of directors provides excellent oversight of clinic service. SB/PV sister city contributes annually to Rehab clinic services to low income community in Puerto Vallarta.

The Board of SB/PV has authorized up to \$300.00 for the transportation of the equipment to Puerto Vallarta.
