Dear Past-Fellow Travelers & other Travelers:

I'm working with Jonathan Benjamin-Alvarado, Ph.D., Assistant Vice Chancellor, Professor of Political Science, University of Nebraska Omaha (Romie Alvarado's son.) Anyway, Jonathan and I have been discussing a group trip to CUBA in late May. Jonathan just returned from Havana, Cuba, he has been going to Cuba for over 20 years with political science students and people interested in visiting Cuba.

Jonathan works with an American travel agent that moved to Cuba. They have come up with tentative cost based on 10-15 participants (land cost only \$2,440-double occupancy) OR 16-20 participants (land cost only \$2,260-double occupancy). This is an arrival date on Sunday and departure date the next Sunday. This includes accommodations, breakfast everyday, 7 meals, ground transportation in Cuba, entrance/program fees associated with scheduled activities, guided visits and other expenses.

I have not looked at airfare or ground transportation to and from LAX. I would like to look into flying from LAX to Cancun, Mexico, staying a few days then flying directly from Cancun to Havana, Cuba. Tentatively, the cost of air, ground transportation and hotel would add another \$1,000 to the cost. Again, these are tentative cost.

If you are interested in being part of the travel group, please get back to me ASAP.

Note: Cuba has a warm tropical climate with two distinct seasons. The best time to visit is from December to May, when you can expect dry, sunny days and plenty of blue skies. The wet season begins in June and, previously, visitors to Cuba would have avoided travel entirely between August and October, when there is also a risk of hurricanes.
