
CONGRATULATIONS TO NEW BOARD MEMBERS

INITIAL AGREEMENT BETWEEM "NINOS DE ROMA, A.C." AND VOLUNTEER MEDIC OF MEDICAL CLINIC

The purpose of this agreement of volunteerism is so that "Ninos de Roma A.C." authorizes a monthly stipend as an initiative so that a qualified volunteer provides medical attention in the medical clinic located at Los Garzas Avenue 532 in the municipal agency of Boca de Tomatlan.

AGREEMENT

The parties agree to the terms established in this contract in the following manner.

CONDITIONS

- 1. The volunteer promises to open and to represent the clinic from Monday to Friday from 10:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.
- 2. The volunteer shall provide medical services in accord with doctors or other personnel, shall maintain the principal medical areas in clean order, shall facilitate communication among the community, "Ninos de Roma A.C.", the Medical Organization of Boca A.C., and other obligations that might be required.
- 3. The volunteer shall be present most of the time, but shall be in contact with Cynthis Leigh if he/she cannot be present during medical hours.
- The financial agreement shall be for \$5,000.00 pesos per month paid on the 15th of the month beginning November of 2020 until April 2021.

This agreement is valid for 6 months and may be renewed for an additional 6 months providing that dthere is agreement between the volunteer and "Ninos de Roma A.C."
