

Forgive me for sending this email to multiple parties involved with Santa Barbara/Puerto Vallarta sister city program. I was not sure to whom it should be directed.

2022 will mark the 50th Anniversary of the Santa Barbara / Puerto Vallarta sister city program. It was 1972 when the cities decided to co-operate in a cultural and supportive exchange that has thrived for 50 years! The recent CoVid aid response from the Santa Barbara committee was heartwarming and stomach filling, to say the least!

2022 will hopefully provide both cities a chance to sigh and return to a more normal routine. And 50 years of Sister Cities should be celebrated! We propose the 50th anniversary is a perfect time to initiate the FIRST Puerto Vallarta Art Museum! Puerto Vallarta has a lengthy colonial art history, but the identity of Puerto Vallarta as an "Art town" really blossomed and grew beginning in the late 1950's with people like Ramón Barragan and Manuel Lepe who created a new style for the city. 2022 seems like an opportune time to stage an exhibition with the theme of "75 Years of Art in Puerto Vallarta." Then we discovered 2022 is also the 50th anniversary of the Sister City collaboration with Santa Barbara! We should have a complimentary exhibition of PV art in Santa Barbara!

I am president of a US 501c3 non-profit named **PVShares** whose goals are to support the Arts in Puerto Vallarta. Please visit <a href="https://www.PVShares.org">www.PVShares.org</a> We were recently presented with an opportunity to partner with a local Museum AC (Asociation Civil - the Mexican non-profit designation) to initiate just such an exhibition and to stage it in a downtown venue - which may become the new Puerto Vallarta Museum.

**PVShares**, as our name suggests, wants to SHARE WITH and INVEST IN Puerto Vallarta for the well-being of the whole city. We especially focus on the Arts of Puerto Vallarta. We are a relatively new organization and received our 501c3 status about a year ago, just days after the first announcement of the Covid lock-downs. Bad timing to say the least! But we have been ZOOMING and working hard at moving ahead with planning and initiating projects and funding.

We are seeking funding for the exhibition and eventually funding for an Art Museum. Big plans but ones we believe in! I write today to ask for the help of the SB/PV Sister City Committee to help us realize this art exhibition and museum. ## 50th Anniversary Mosaic Bench

Next year 2022 is the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary of first contact to establish the Santa Barbara/Puerto Vallarta Sister City relationship.

In the beginning City Councilman Richard Hidalgo on March 3, 1972 wrote a letter to the Honorable Municipal President of Puerto Vallarta, C. Marcelo Alcaraz Guerena, asking that he seek approval for the Puerto Vallarta City Council to formally recognize the Sister City designation for our two cities.

To memorialize this golden anniversary, SB/PV Sister City members are fundraising \$5,000.00 USD for a Commemorative 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Mosaic Bench to be constructed in Lazaro Cardenas Mosaic Park which is located in PV Romantic Zone, a short block from Playa Los Arcos Hotel. Lazaro Cardenas Mosaic Park is becoming known worldwide for the beautiful and creative use of mosaic tile murals on all surfaces of the park.

The artist in charge of the project, Natasha Moraga would construct the mural, designed by local SB artist and Sister City member, Ann Hefferman. The mural design will integrate Santa Barbara and Puerto Vallarta images that celebrate 50 years of the long enduring and award winning Sister City relationship.

#### The Total amount raised and pledged to date is \$4,000.00 with \$1,000.00 remaining.
