

Las Posadas is an Advent celebration revolving around the concept of hospitality. It originated in Spain and is still very popular today. The word Posada means "shelter, "lodging," or "Inn". The Posadas re-enacts Mary and Joseph's Journey from Nazareth of Bethlehem and their search for lodging along the way. These celebrations last for nine days, representing the months of Mary's pregnancy.

The people of Mexico participate whole heartedly in Las Posadas. While these celebrations provide opportunities for religious worship, they also provide an occasion for cultural and social exchanges. Some of the major celebrations include Passion Week, Día de los Muertos and Christmas festivities

including the Posadas.
