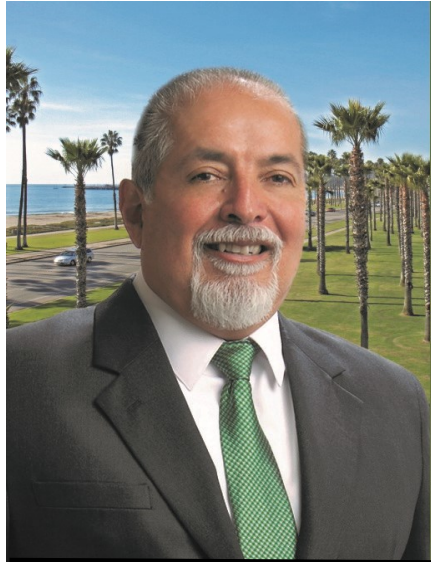

Violin superstar Anne Akiko Meyers returns to the Santa Barbara Symphony to ignite the stage with “*Fandango*”, a new piece written specifically for her by Mexican composer Arturo Marquez, which will be making its world premiere debut by the LA Philharmonic at the Hollywood Bowl just a few months prior to this performance. This new violin concerto showcases the fireworks of Akiko Meyers’ dynamic playing style with the rhythmic movement and Latin sound Marquez is famous for. The mastery of the orchestra is on display in Rimsky-Korsakov’s “*Capriccio Espagnol*”, weaving in Spanish folk themes and in particular showcases the dexterity of the strings who play “quasi guitarra” sounding like guitars.
