

CELEBRATING 50 YEARS OF FRIENDSHIP ANNUAL VISIT TO PUERTO VALLARTA

November 29 – December 08, 2022

Presently we have over 75 members signed up for the sister city 50th anniversary trip to Puerto Vallarta November 29 to December 8. The planned activities for the 50th anniversary promises to be exciting memorable festivities of past projects in Puerto Vallarta gatherings and adventurous excursions to current projects that have gained national recognition as one of the most productive and successful sister city relationships. One of the most gratifying experiences over the last fifty years is the deep long-lasting friendships and new ones that develop with every visit. We look forward to seeing on-going projects of our Puerto Vallarta friends. One award winning project we will be visiting is the Santa Barbara Rehabilitation Clinic, built in the late 1980's with funds provided by SB/PV Sister City and our SB Rotary Club partners. San Luis Obispo University architectural students designed the Rehabilitation Clinic where they spent their 5th year of studies in Puerto Vallarta and their studies where sponsored by a Japanese Kanazawa Scholarship. We are talking about an exciting international project here.

Group visits to Puerto Vallarta started in 1972 with hotel of choice being Hotel Playa los Arcos. Over the last 50 years we are still staying at Play los Arcos and have seen it grow with a few additional rooms, others remodeled and a recent restaurant up-grade with a new one added. Hotel Playa los Arcos will provide a stage on the beach with hosted dinner and entertainment provided by Ballet Folkloric Xiutla who visited Santa Barbara in 2002, we will also see the Los Volcanes youth symphony perform with instruments donated by SB/PV Sister City and SB Rotary Clubs. A visit highlighting our newest project is the 50th Anniversary bench at the mosaic park located near Los Arcos Hotel. We also hope to start work on a new Four-Pillars monument, memorializing the Four Endearing Pillars of Friendship (Amistad), Brotherhood (Hermandad), Respect (Respeto) and Love (Amor).

The festive afternoon included both DJ Music by D&D, Diana Guerrero and Dalet Alvarado as well as a live performance by talented singer Irma Segura. Guests mingled, enjoyed a delicious catered Mexican dinner by Chiltepin Catering, a lively auction of donated gift items, and dancing to favorite musical selections. Attendees included members from combined Santa Barbara Sister Cities, many of whom will be attending the November Santa Barbara Puerto Vallarta Sister Cities trip to Puerto Vallarta to celebrate the groups 50th Anniversary working together.

The Santa Barbara/Puerto Vallarta Sister Cities Committee program is a direct cultural and social exchange between Santa Barbara and Puerto Vallarta, established in 1972 through the efforts of local city officials and interested citizens and includes countless programs of community outreach and cooperation. The program is a living legacy left by the late President Dwight D. Eisenhower who conceived the program and initiated it in 1956.

The grass-roots strength of the Sister City movement rests on the people-to-people programs, and the direct contact activity of the individual Sister Cities. Over \$30,000.00 was raised throughout the past year to support the Volcanes Food Bank that supplies meal ingredients to over 500 families that have been economically
