

# OPPORTUNITY FOR OUR SOCIAL PROJECTS IN P. V.

Raymundo Galvan, Director of Migrant Care, on behalf of the government of the state of Jalisco, informs about projects that the State can support. The association of Jalisco clubs need to make a list of projects that the clubs want to support, the projects must be of social or community infrastructure, the amount can reach 3,000 000 pesos,(158,000.00 USD) the club has to contribute with a Google station that is made up of 40 laptops, an internet system, which can be installed anywhere, training for teachers and students by experts is included, the cost is 300,000 pesos, (\$15,800.00 USD) the migrant club will decide to which primary or secondary school it will be donated. Priority will be given to the projects of our association, as long as we send the list of projects in one week.
