be provided in a flyer for distribution to all students in public and private schools.


We will be looking for the support of our membership for this very worthwhile program.

I Madonnari in Puerto Vallarta February 9, 10, 11, 2024

The first ever Chalk Art Festival in Mexico was introduced in Puerto Vallarta as a cultural exchange as a joint effort by Santa Barbara Sister Cities and the Santa Barbara Children's Creative Program. Many of the same artist still participate.

SB/PV Sister City raises each funds to support the local I Madonnari and the Puerto Vallarta I Madonnari. Several artists from Santa Barbara go to PV and our group pays airfare and hotel rooms for 4 to 5 artists each year.

The winner of the I Madonnari in Puerto Vallarta wins airfare and accommodations to participate in our local I Madonnaru in May.
