Lifetime Membership??

Did you notice that on this year's membership application form there is a category for <u>Lifetime</u> <u>Membership?</u> The cost is \$500 per person. You may wonder why someone would opt for this???

- 1.) The perk for a donation of \$500 will give the status of a "Lifetime Membership."
- 2.) You will receive a new larger size gold badge to denote this special status.
- 3.) There is the convenience of not having to remember to renew your membership each year.
- 4.) There is also the fact that if you opt for the \$500 donation it becomes tax deductible.
- 5.) If you have an IRA retirement account and are age qualified you may want to talk to your accountant regarding the tax saving benefits if you donate from your required annual distribution.
- 6.) Funds generated from the \$500 donation will go to the **SB/PV Endowment Fund**.
- 7.) What is the **Endowment Fund,** you ask? The endowment fund is a charitable gift that keeps on giving. It was established a few years ago to establish an account that can accept tax deductible donations, such as bequests. The fund principle is invested and the proceeds are used in a number of ways, such as continued funding of scholarships for students in PV, contribution to special major project in PV or a project requiring major funding to be used from a number of sources.

There are many positive things to consider. The tax information is from members who have opted for this lifetime membership.



5 CPR Training Kits go to Puerto Vallarta Red Cross

Bret Russell President of International Firemen Training Association (IFTA) donated the attached 5 CPR in School Training Kits to Puerto Vallarta Red Cross. They are in San Juan Capistrano and Angel Nieves of Huntington Park picked them up, and had them packaged for shipment to PV. The cost came in at \$320. The SB/PV Board approved the expenditure to cover the cost of the shipping at our last board meeting. In addition, PV Red Cross has asked for this and other mannequins and equipment for their first response paramedic training school. The official request will be made in a future email.

Submission Categories

Writing / Poetry

Students may submit creative writing, essays, anecdotes, poetry, or other written works that follow the content guidelines. Submissions must be written in English and must not exceed 500 words.

Classic Art

Media accepted includes but is not limited to oil, acrylic, watercolor, charcoal, and colored pencils. Digital art is accepted in a separate category.

Digital Art / Photography

Digital mediums will be accepted in this category. Moving art pieces will not be accepted. Submissions must have a minimum of 1350x1080 pixels.

To submit your entry, please give finished artwork and a completed entry form to a teacher or drop them off at Children's Creative Project at 3970 La Colina Rd Suite 9, Santa Barbara, CA.

Deadline for submissions: April 12, 2024

What is YAAS?

The Young Artists and Authors Showcase (YAAS) is an annual contest that encourages youth worldwide to express the mission of Sister Cities International through original artwork, literature, and photography.

How is it judged?

Submissions are centered around the theme of "Climatescapes" and judged based on creativity, composition, and theme interpretation.

Eligibility and Guidelines

Students are to check in with their member cities to ensure eligibility for this YAAS competition. After this coordination, the application can be filled out for submission. Students must be 13-18 years old to participate in the YAAS competition. One entry per student per category.

Are there prizes?

First and second place will be awarded in each category. First place prize is \$150, second place is \$100.
