Evie worked for the Santa Barbara Sheriff's Office for over 30 years, both full-time and later as an extra-help employee. The Sheriff's Office was her second family. The one thing she was most proud of was the Law Enforcement Exchange Program that she created through the Santa Barbara Puerto Vallarta Sister Cities Association, the City of Puerto Vallarta, Mexico. As a result, there was an exchange of visits and training between the Sheriff's Office and the Puerto Vallarta Municipal Police Department. This lasted over 15 years and expanded to include Provincial and Federal agencies. That training has been



credited in saving the lives of a number of Mexican law enforcement officers. For her dedicated work in coordinating this program she was awarded the Santa Barbara Sheriff's Office Distinguished Service Medal. She is greatly missed by her friends within Sister cities.
